



Mawnan School has always placed great importance on regular attendance and its positive impact on students' academic progress and overall development. Consistent attendance is crucial to ensure that children receive the education they deserve and have the best opportunity to reach their full potential.

The school's policy regarding family holidays during term time is in line with the guidelines set by the Department for Education. We can only authorise absences in exceptional circumstances, such as family bereavement or illness. Absences for reasons such as family holidays, birthdays, or visiting relatives are considered unauthorised and may result in penalties from the local authority.

We strongly encourage you to plan family holidays during the designated school breaks to ensure your child does not miss out on valuable learning experiences.

We understand that there may be unique situations where taking a holiday during term time cannot be avoided. In such cases, we kindly request that you submit a 'request for leave during term time form' to the school office, explaining the exceptional circumstances and providing any supporting documents. Please note that each request will be considered on an individual basis, and that absence for holidays during term time will only be granted in <u>exceptional</u> cases.

There's still plenty that can be done though to limit its influence – especially in relation to young people, who are often more susceptible to sensationalist headlines.
