Punctuality

The school gates are open for **8:40am** and are **closed at 8:50am**. Please ensure that your child arrives at school before 8:50am.

A few children are arriving after 8.50am which is impacting on their learning as they are missing the start of the lesson.

COVID-19 Update

We will continue to do everything in our control to mitigate the spread of the virus at school and keeping the school staffed to ensure that our children receive their full education.

Our mitigation measures remain unchanged and we will continue to require your full support, vigilance and understanding.

Our mitigation measures are:

1. Remain in our class bubbles whilst we are in the school building. Staggered playtimes, lunchtimes and key stage collective worship will remain in place. Key stage bubbles will only mix outside.

- 2. Routine and regular handwashing along with good respiratory hygiene.
- 3. Classrooms will be well ventilated.
- 4. Enhanced cleaning remains in place.
- 5. Staff will lateral flow test regularly.

6. Staff will be wearing facemasks in communal areas and when working in close proximity to children.

Please ensure that you play your part and follow our guidance:

1. If your child develops COVID-19 symptoms, they should stay at home and you should book them a PCR test (NOT a Lateral Flow Test). If your child develops COVID-19 symptoms at school, they will be sent home and you should book them a PCR test. If your child tests positive for COVID-19, they will need to self-isolate. (The rest of the household does not need to self-isolate if they are under 18 or fully vaccinated). Please let us know if someone in your household tests positive so we can provide support for you. 2. Please make use of the lateral flow tests - Twice weekly lateral flow testing should continue for all education staff and all families and households of children attending schools. Please use lateral flow tests to test the household

before returning to school tomorrow.

3. Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school.

4. Wear face coverings if you are unable to maintain a 2 metre distance whilst on school grounds.

5. Swiftly exit the school grounds and do not gather in groups.

6. Keep the one-way system clear so everyone is able to safely enter and exit the school grounds. To avoid crowding at the end of the day please could we request that you keep to the one-way system and do not stand by the front gates.

Remote Learning

To minimise the disruption to your child's education we will continue to set remote learning via Google Classrooms for children who are isolating. The learning that is set for the children is set in a familiar routine with resources that are both familiar and accessible to them.

All clubs start at 3:15pm and end at 4:15pm.


We are very sorry but we are unable to offer a club for key stage 1 this term.

Weather Updates

Snow has <u>not</u> been forecast but we just wanted to remind you of our school closure procedure.



If we know that we need to close, the school before the school day starts then we will let you know via ClassDojo.

If we need to contact you during the day to let you know that we need to close the school due to snow then we will do this <u>via ClassDojo</u>.

For this reason, please check that you are getting the notifications. If you did not receive the messages on ClassDojo please speak to Miss Pridmore.

Attendance Reminder

We do understand there are times when children will need to be absent from school for a number of reasons. As a result, we will only consider authorising absences in the following instances:

- For sickness or ill health
- For COVID-19 isolation
- For medical consultant appointments which fall during school hours
- For religious or cultural observances
- For a family emergency

If your child is absent, please <u>phone</u> the school by 9:00am on the first day of absence and provide us with the reason for their absence. The school is obliged to keep a record of absences and these are recorded on your child's report. Unauthorised absence and persistent lateness must be reported to the Local Authority's Attendance and Welfare Officer for further support and action. Please do not send message via ClassDojo as they may be missed.

Reminder about Holidays during term time

We also understand that after a very testing time we would all like nothing more than a holiday. Please remember that under current legislation parent/carers taking their child on an unauthorised holiday in term time could be subject to a fixed penalty fine. This is something we would like to avoid happening. Thank you for your support and understanding.

There have been amendments to the Education Regulations (Pupil Registration 2006) act. These amendments remove reference to family holiday and extended leave as well as the statutory threshold of ten school days. The amendments make clear that head teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Whilst we understand that some absences may include times when your child is ill or attending appointments, (preferably out of school time) it is important that we all work together to try to ensure that your child has the best possible chance of success whilst at school.

If you decide to still take your child out of school, without permission, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may refer the matter to Cornwall Council who may decide to take legal action against you. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine per child, per parent, of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the penalty notice may result in Court action. Persistent absences not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates Court, leading to fines up to £2,500 and / or custodial sentences. The Council may also apply for the costs incurred in taking the matter to court.

PE Uniform

One of the positive Impacts of our COVID operating procedures is that the children have been coming into school in their PE uniform. By removing the changing element, we have increased the amount of time that children are active and have almost eliminated lost property!



The children should be coming into school on their PE days in their Mawnan PE uniform. From September, we added the Mawnan zipped sports top and tracksuit bottoms to our uniform list. The zipper top and tracksuit trousers are for when the weather is cooler and will mean that the children look smart and are comfortable.

Jumpers or cardigans are for school uniform day and the zipped sports top is for PE days only.



Parent Governor Vacancy - January 2022

Dear Parent/Carer,

PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTION

I am writing to you to invite you to stand for election as a Parent Governor, or nominate another parent to do so. In our school we have provision for two Parent Governor(s) and there is currently ONE vacancy.

The Governing Board, with the Headteacher, has overall responsibility for the running of the school. Governing Boards have three core strategic functions:

- Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- Holding the Headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils; and
- Overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

No special qualifications are needed and the most important thing is to have a keen interest in the school and be prepared to play an active part in the Governing Board's work. However, we would particularly welcome nominations from parents with the following skills: background in business and finance, or someone with SEN or social care experience. Training is available for all Governors and this Governing Board has an expectation that those new to being a Governor attend free induction training. The enclosed sheet summarises the circumstances under which someone cannot serve as a Governor. In addition, parents/carers who have paid employment in the school for 500 or more hours per academic year or who are elected members of the Local Authority are not eligible to stand in these elections. Nominations must be from parents or carers with children at the school on the day that nominations close.

If you would like to stand for election please complete the nomination form and return it to the school no later than **3.15pm on Monday**, **17/01/2022**. You may also include a short personal statement to support your nomination, which should be no longer than 250 words. Self-nominations will be accepted, but if you are nominating another parent please seek their prior consent.

If there are more nominations than vacancies the election will be by secret ballot. If that is necessary, voting papers will be sent to all parents together with details of the ballot procedure.
