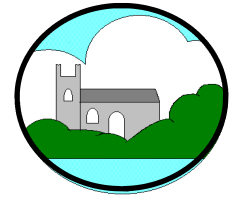

CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR NEXT WEEK

CLASS 1

Literacy - Next week we will be continuing our non fiction focus and will write all about the chicks. It's likely to be a very exciting time so a perfect learning opportunity!

Numeracy - Continuing to measure and weigh using standard and non-standard units. We will then compare and discuss our findings.

CLASS 2

Literacy - BFG, Giant poems. Dictionary skills; index, contents and glossary.

Numeracy - Y1 - addition/subtraction, including money problems. Y2 - addition/subtraction/multiplication/division, including money problems.

Topic - Finishing our Mawnan Books & The Diamond Jubilee.

CLASS 3

Literacy - Starting a new two week unit called 'Performance and favourite poems.' The children will read and write poems; especially own dialogue poems. This will provide opportunities for children to choose and prepare poems or stories for performance, including thinking about appropriate expression, and tone.

Numeracy - Addition and subtraction of two and three digit numbers including mental calculations and written methods. Word problems that involve these operations.

Topic - Diamond Jubilee: work on the forthcoming jubilee celebrations. We are focusing on the decade 1959 - 1969 and studying a few of the key events from this period of time; preparing and completing a display of this period to represent our research.

CLASS 4

This week we are going to be doing a mini Jubilee Topic.

Literacy - Looking at some of the letters the queen wrote as a child and writing our own letters to the queen to explain how our childhood is different to hers.

Numeracy - Converting units of measure and reading measures.

Topic - Researching toys that the Queen might have played with as a child, making bunting, writing our own anthem and designing our own board game.
