YEAR 1 REPORT 2012

Please find enclosed your child's annual report and Learning Journey. Your child's learning journey is now yours to keep, enjoy and shows the progression of your child's learning throughout the year. Many thanks for all your contributions.

You will notice that next to nearly all the evidence collected there will be the following initials:

"CI" - child initiated - your child will have chosen this activity. This is where we really see what your children are capable of or understand without being helped in any way.

"AI" - adult initiated. This means that an adult will have either suggested an activity or asked the child to complete an activity, saying this, they may not have been working closely with the child.

"AL" - adult lead. This is where an adult will be working closely with the child/class. The activity will have been adult directed and supported e.g. whole class teaching/questioning.

"AE" - adult extended - this might be where a child was working on a child initiated activity and we have seen an opportunity to extend their learning or find out if they can be challenged in anyway.

"Super hero challenge"/"SH" - these are open ended investigations to extend the Year 1 children and are open to any reception children who want to have a go.

Please can I ask you to keep your learning journeys for at least a year (don't throw them out) as if we were to get an Ofsted inspection during the next school year, it would be really helpful if I could have the option to borrow a few to show them their quality and a completed state.

If you would like to discuss any element of your child's report please feel free to make an appointment and I would be more than happy to discuss it with you.
