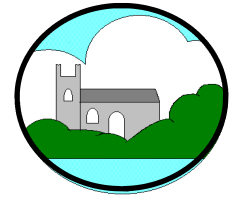

CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION

CLASS 1

Literacy: Looking at "goody" and "baddie" characters in traditional stories and having a go at making up our own characters for the stories we will be writing next week.

Numeracy: Continuing to use money to pay and using non standard measures to measure volume and weight.

ALL CLASS 1 & CLASS 2 CHILDREN

All children need to bring a box in (no bigger than a shoe/cereal box) to make instruments from. They need to be in school by Thursday, 15th November 2012 please.

CLASS 2

Literacy: Will include posters and diagrams linked to our topic. The children will also be writing some poems and making pictures about light and dark.

Numeracy: Money, coin recognition, addition and giving change.

RE: Will include some work on Diwali.

Science: Light and electricity in their science work, this will include electrical safety and starting to make simple circuits with bulbs and batteries.

CLASS 3

Literacy: Recounts and Newspaper reports. We will be looking at a range of national and local newspaper articles or magazines and identifying key language & presentational features, e.g. headlines, paragraphs, quotations, photographs (with captions.)

Numeracy: Solving word problems, single and multi-step problems using all four operations.

CLASS 4

Literacy: Acting out and writing our own play scripts.

Numeracy: Interpret scales, converting measure and calculator problems.

Topic: Identifying rivers using Google earth and OS maps. The water cycle.

RE: Daya is coming in this week to teach us about Diwali.

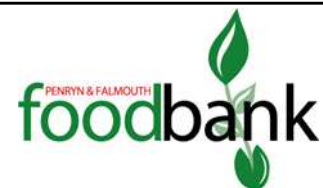
