# CLASS CURRICULUM **INFORMATION**

### CLASS 1

Literacy: Looking at Handa's Surprise next week, exploring stories from a variety of cultures in literacy.

Numeracy: Continuing to count in 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's, touch on doubling and continue our work on recording number sentences.

Topic: Preparing for the Class 1 'wedding.' The role play ceremony will be taking place on Wednesday morning. You are very welcome to join us! If you can, please meet us at School at 11am prompt, and we'll walk down to St Michael's Church together; back in time for lunch!

#### CLASS 2

Literacy: We will be completing our work on electricity. We will then be finding out about living on an island from the Katie Morag books & from Lizzy. Written work will be mainly topic

Numeracy: Time and practical measures (including cookery postponed from last week.)

### CLASS 3

Literacy: Starting an exciting new unit Creating Images (poetry.) Initially we will be thinking and writing about the wind. This fits nicely with the work we are doing on the Storm for the Christmas Play.

Numeracy: New unit 3D shapes and handling data is linked to our current mathematics targets, this will include describing 3D shapes and visualising 3D objects from 2D drawings, making nets of common 3D solids.

### CLASS 4

Literacy: Our play scripts have taken us rather longer than expected so next week we are going to act them out and uplevel them.

Numeracy: More on fractions and written methods for multiplication. Target focused work and percentages.

**Topic:** We have a **visitor** coming in to tell us how the river and its features benefited us during

Science: To make predictions about which types of water contain dissolved materials and test these predictions.
