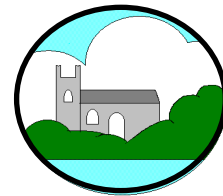

## CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION

### Class 1

**Literacy:** Working towards creating an afternoon tea for all the people who have volunteered and helped us in class. This will mean that we will be writing thank you letters/cards, writing invitations, writing menus and then reading recipes and taking orders/being waiters and waitresses for real; and practicing our speaking and listening skills!

**Numeracy:** Using our skills for real when we bake for our tea party, organise the tables, seating plans and cutlery. We will also be working more on halving and doubling problem solving.

### Class 2

**Literacy/Topic:** Traditional Stories. Writing a story book. Preparing our annual class magazine (including word processing.)

**Numeracy:** Times tables (multiplication and division.)  
Handling data (Venn and Carroll diagrams.)  
Shape, angles, corners and turning.

### Class 3

**Literacy:** Short Stories, Look at the features of short stories including character, settings and plot. Write parts of short stories.

**Numeracy:** Read time and understand units of time in both digital and analogue format. Read, draw, interpret and describe a time graph; convert between units of time.

**Science:** We are doing a short unit of work on fossil fuels, renewable energy and saving energy.

### Class 4

**Literacy:** Drafting and proof reading our War stories.

**Numeracy:** Cancelling fractions with common denominators and adding and subtracting fractions. We will also be recapping on our written multiplication method using decimals.
