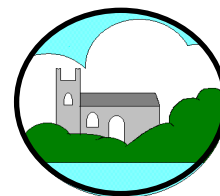

CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION

Class 1

English: - We will be creating our role play garden centre and will be working on labels and seed packets. We will also be filling in forms for floristry orders. (Any spare flowers or plants would be very gratefully received.

Maths: We will be learning how to use money in our role play shops, initially starting with 1ps and 2ps.

Class 2

English: Continuing with their work on the Wind in the Willows. Some work will be based on the various characters and there will also be tasks based on 'book cover' design.

Maths: The number system, addition and subtraction, ordering > and <. Number bonds at various levels. A session based on measuring.

Class 3

English: Stories from history: 1066 the year of three battles. Concluding our work on the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings we are learning about the most famous date in English history! Children predict, get into role, tell the story from another point of view, empathise with characters and write their account of the story.

Maths: Week two about time: Read timetables, for example, bus timetables using the 24-hour clock. Calculate time intervals and find a given number of minutes or hours and minutes later; Draw and interpret line graphs and read intermediate points.

Class 3 Camp: Please note that regrettably we are not doing a residential visit/camp this year.

Class 4

English: We will be planning, drafting and writing a character description using techniques that we learnt last week. We will then be voting on which one we think is our best and writing that one up in best.

Maths: We will be plotting co-ordinates in all four quadrants as well as reflecting, translating and rotating shapes.

Topic: We will be researching who the first people in Britain were and making notes on what we find.

Science: We are learning about how the heart works.
