



## CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION

### Class 1

**English:** We will be composing and writing questions about Pendennis Castle and then after our trip- with any luck- writing the answers!

**Maths:** We will be revisiting subtraction! So plenty of games, counting back and singing songs!

### Class 2

**English/Topic:** Will be continuing with their BFG project. Working on the themes of 'meeting the Queen' and Book Reviews. The children will also be making giant's heads.

**Maths:** Work on doubles and halves. Also, addition/subtraction and number bonds.

There will also be a session on 'time.'

### Class 3

**English:** We are continuing to look at stories in imaginary worlds. We shall be writing a story using the 1st and 3rd person, based on the 'Dream Giver' animation.

**Maths:** For the first part of the week we shall be looking at time in both analogue and digital formats. The second half of the week we are focusing on shape created through the plotting of co-ordinates.

**Science:** We are looking at the different parts of the flower and explaining their roles in the fertilisation and pollination process.

**Topic:** Next week we shall be learning about the polar regions and comparing them to our own climate.

### Class 4

**English:** We will be finishing off our performance poems and rehearsing performing them.

**Maths:** We will be multiplying and dividing with fractions as well as recapping on our division methods.

**R.E.:** We will be making our Easter Gardens and reflecting on the Easter Story.
