



CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION

CLASS 1

English: We will be writing about life cycles of quails and mini beasts. We will be looking at time openers and conjunctions such as first, second, third, after that and finally.

Maths: Counting and grouping in 2's, 5's and 10's. The year 1's will be looking at how to record their findings.

e-Safety: Our e-safety lesson this half term will be based on e-mail safety and content..

CLASS 2

English/Topic: The work this week will be building on the previous week's tasks, including writing some of their own stories based on the book. The children will be hopefully be completing their cushions and making some clay creatures. There will also be more work based on plants and animals.

Maths: The class will be re-visiting measures including time and also solving some money problems.

CLASS 3

English: We are going to be focusing on instructional texts based around how to make a pasty. Children will be learning the vocabulary needed for instructions and the format that they take.

Maths: We are going to be focusing on compact methods for both addition and subtraction, and year 4s will be looking at place value in decimals to help them add and subtract decimal numbers.

Science: We are going to be carrying out an investigation to find out which materials block light the best.

Topic: We are going to be looking at the landscape of Cornwall, especially within our local area.

CLASS 4

This term class 4's topic is **The Olympics**.

English: We will be writing non-chronological reports, plays and poems.

History/Geography: We will be learning where the Olympics came from and using maps and atlases to locate different countries around the world. We will also be thinking about foods that would make us good athletes and we hope to do some outdoor cooking.

Science: Interdependence & adaptation. Finding out how plants and animals adapt to suit their environments and how they support each other.

RE: Why do Christians go on Pilgrimages?
