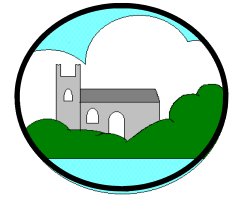

## CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION FOR NEXT WEEK

### CLASS 1

**Literacy** - Exciting vocabulary when writing our own Poem inspired by the Chinese Dragon.  
**Numeracy** - In maths, we will be continuing practicing our counting skills, touching on our awareness of 2D and 3D shape but mainly focussing on subtraction.

### CLASS 2

**Literacy** - The Magic Porridge Pot and some non-fiction work relating to our topic.  
**Numeracy** - Measures.  
**Topic** - Our Body & Chinese New Year.

### CLASS 3

**Literacy** - Shape poetry week 1. Compare & contrast different poems, consider preferences & express opinions.  
**Numeracy** - Studying symmetry of shapes & tessellation of shapes.  
**Science** - How muscles work in combination with the bones to enable movement.

### CLASS 4

**Literacy** - Finishing off our rocket instructions and starting poetry.  
**Numeracy** - Multiplication with decimals and prime numbers and square numbers.  
**Science** - Solar system; planet order and distance apart.  
**Topic** - The Moon landing.
