Some highlights for our final week of term





Father Christmas and his elves will be doing a remote visit this year to ensure that they are not isolating on 24th December.

Covid-19

We are all looking forward to the Christmas holidays and the opportunity to see our families. We'd like to remind everyone that it is essential that we continue to follow government guidance to keep our school community safe. Please take special care this weekend because if any class bubbles close next week then the children and staff will be isolating on Christmas day.

To keep us all safe please continue to follow our safety plans:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must self-isolate the whole household during this time
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school (if this is not possible wear a mask)
- Do not come into the school building
- Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
- Swiftly exit the school grounds
- Do not gather in groups
- Follow the government's guidance outside of school at all times

If your child is isolating because they or a family member have Covid symptoms please ensure that you phone the school office. Please **do not** message teachers on Class Dojo in case messages are missed.

Internet Safety at Christmas

Many children receive gifts that require going online (smartphones, gaming devices, tablets, etc.). We have compiled a short checklist to help keep your children as safe as possible whilst using their new devices.

- Research the device, make sure you have an idea of how your child will be using it. <u>Parents' Guide to Technology |</u> <u>Safer Internet Centre</u> is a very useful website which provides helpful information about different devices (smartphones, tablets, games consoles etc.)
- 2. Have a look at the device before Christmas day and set up security and privacy settings paying special attention to location settings. If you can't set it up before Christmas ensure you sit with your child and set it up together. Checklist Setting up your child's devices is a helpful guide.
- Look into the parental controls, the website below is a helpful guide to these. <u>Parental Controls</u> & <u>Privacy Settings</u> <u>Guides</u>
- 4. Finally, take time to play on the new device together with your child, talk about what the child is using it for and what they know about staying safe online.

How to report an incident

If your child tells you or shows you something inappropriate that they have seen online please report it. It could help prevent this happening to someone else.



The first place it needs reporting is to the APP/ Website/Game it happened on.

If you are worried about online abuse or the way someone has been communicating online let CEOP know. You can report it by visiting www.ceop.police.uk/ or by clicking the button on

our website. The website will guide you through how to make a report.
