COVID

COVID cases in Cornwall continue to rise.

We want our community to be safe and not to have the upset and inconvenience of having to isolate.

Please ensure that you follow our guidance:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must self-isolate the whole household during this time. Please note that the symptoms of the new variants vary and in many of the recent confirmed cases there has been a runny nose and a scratchy throat.
- Please make use of the lateral flow tests.
- Do <u>not</u> use a rapid lateral flow test if you have COVID-19 symptoms. Get a PCR test and self-isolate.
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school
- Wear face coverings if you are unable to maintain a 2 metre distance
- Do not come into the school building
- Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
- Swiftly exit the school grounds
- Do not gather in groups
- Keep the one-way system clear so everyone is able to safely enter and exit the school grounds
