

Free School Meals

The Together for Families team at Cornwall Council have provided us with the following information to share with parents/carers regarding free school meals eligibility criteria:

If eligible for free school meals, your child will also be eligible for pupil premium. This is additional funding paid to the school to support your child in their learning.

Free school meals eligibility criteria if you receive benefits:

A child is eligible for free school meals if their parent/carer (or the child themselves) receives any of the following benefits:

Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods); Income Support (IS);

Jobseeker's Allowance (income-based) and equal-based Jobseeker's Allowance;

Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal-based Employment and Support Allowance;

Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190;

Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit; Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC);

Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Supports.

If you are claiming the benefits listed below you are not eligible for free school meals. This is regardless of what other benefits/credits are being claimed.

Working Tax Credit;

Contribution-Based Jobseeker's Allowance and/or Contribution-Based Employment and Support Allowance.
