Sports Day

We need to have two sports days this year to keep our bubbles separate. Oppie and Topper will have their event on Wednesday 7th July (our original date) and Pico, Fusion and Dart will have their event on Friday 9th July.

Our amazing PE Leader Mr Studd has planned a great afternoon of activities but we regret to inform you that we will not be having spectators at sports day this year. The government have stated that multiple groups of 30 people could attend a school sports day event but everyone in the group has to be socially distanced. This would be extremely challenging to manage.

We appreciate that this is disappointing because sports day is a treasured event in the school calendar but I would like our focus to be on ensuring that the children have a positive and enjoyable experience and keeping our community safe.

Covid-19

On Monday, the government announced that the lockdown restrictions are not easing for the next few weeks and this coupled with the steep rise in positive covid cases locally will impact on some of our planned events for the summer. Our children have missed a lot of school this year and our mission is to keep all of them in school and avoid any bubble closures. We also want to ensure that our fantastic Year 6 children have the very best final few weeks of their time at Mawnan.

With Covid numbers rising again the likelihood of bubbles isolating and returning to remote learning increases so we must all remain vigilant and continue to follow the government guidance. We want our community to be safe and not to have the upset and inconvenience of having to isolate.

Please ensure that you follow our guidance:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must selfisolate the whole household during this time. Please note that the symptoms of the new variants vary and in many of the recent confirmed cases there has been a runny nose and a scratchy throat.
- Please make use of the lateral flow tests.
- Do not use a rapid lateral flow test if you have COVID-19 symptoms.
 Get a PCR test and self-isolate.
- Maintain a 2 metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school
- Wear face coverings if you are unable to maintain a 2 metre distance
- Do not come into the school building
- Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
- Swiftly exit the school grounds
- Do not gather in groups
- Keep the one-way system clear so everyone is able to safely enter and exit the school grounds

Lateral Flow Tests
