The service is structured into three sessions: 3:15 pm - 4:15 pm, 4:15 pm - 5:30 pm, and 5:30 pm - 6:00 pm, each priced at £5.

To secure a place in this provision, parents and carers are required to complete a registration form, available for download from our website or collection from the school office. Once submitted to wraparound@mawnanschool.com or delivered to the school office, you will be able to make your bookings.

We kindly request that bookings are made at least 24 hours in advance, with payment required at the time of booking. Should you need to cancel, please provide 24 hours' notice to avoid incurring charges.

If you are paying with vouchers, information will be sent to you via email.

Suncream

As the weather is currently, dry sunny and warm we will be spending more time outside.

We kindly request that you apply long lasting sunscreen to your child before they leave for school in the morning. If you deem it necessary, please provide your child with their own named sunscreen for reapplication during the day. If children are bringing sun lotion into school they must apply their own sunscreen and refrain from sharing it with others due to potential allergies and skin sensitivities.

Please could we ask that you ensure your child comes to school equipped with a sun hat, clearly labelled with their name and a water bottle, which will enable your child to stay adequately hydrated throughout the day.




