

COVID

This week the government announced that the COVID restrictions are lifting on the 19th of July and schools have been given revised and very brief operating procedures.

Our current risk assessment procedures, including class bubbles, will be in place until the end of this academic year to reduce the risk of transmission or isolation.

We have had a number of suspected cases but no confirmed cases this week. Sadly, this is not the case in lots of school locally.

Thank you for supporting our COVID measures by keeping your children off school and getting them tested.

Please ensure that you follow our guidance:

- If your child or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms or awaiting the outcome of a test, do not come to school - you must self-isolate the whole household during this time. Please note that the symptoms of the new variants vary and in many of the recent confirmed cases there has been a runny nose and a scratchy throat.
- · Please make use of the lateral flow tests.
- Do <u>not</u> use a rapid lateral flow test if you have COVID-19 symptoms.
 Get a PCR test and self-isolate.
- Maintain a 2-metre distance from other families and staff whilst at school
- Wear face coverings if you are unable to maintain a 2-metre distance
 - Do not come into the school building
 - Arrive at the correct staggered time for drop off and pick-ups (only one parent to drop off)
 - Swiftly exit the school grounds
 - Do not gather in groups
 - Keep the one-way system clear so everyone is able to safely enter and exit the school grounds

COVID Symptoms in Children

The symptoms of Covid-19 in children can look like symptoms of other common illnesses such as colds, strep throat, or allergies. The most common symptoms of Covid-19 in children are fever and cough, but children may have any of these signs or symptoms of Covid-19:

- · Fever or chills
- ·Cough
- · Nasal congestion or runny nose
- · New loss of taste or smell
- · Sore throat
- · Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- · Diarrhoea
- · Nausea or vomiting
- ·Stomach ache
- · Tiredness
- ·Headache
- · Muscle or body aches
- · Poor appetite

Please ensure that you keep your child at home if they are unwell and we ask that you are extra cautious and get them tested for Covid-19 before they return to school.

Lateral Flow Tests
