Wrap up warm!

As the weather is getting colder, please make sure your child comes to school with warm layers, a jumper or cardigan is essential and vests or thermal base layers are recommended on colder days. To mitigate the risk of Covid-19 transmission we are keeping the classroom windows open to improve ventilation.

We are also continuing to use the field to ensure that the children are playing separately in their bubbles. If your child is in Key Stage 2 it would be helpful if they could come into school with wellies and waterproofs on wet days.
