

# CLASS CURRICULUM INFORMATION – 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2017

---

## CLASS 1

**Maths:** We will be consolidating the work we have been doing on doubling/ halving and counting in 2's and 10's. The children will be solving word problems and the year 1 children will be looking at (reading) number sentences in order to find the answers.

**English:** We will be focussing on "up scaling" our sentences. In order to do this, we will be sentence doctors "curing" "unhealthy" and "boring" sentences by adding wow words and punctuation.

## CLASS 2

**English:** Next week Class 2 will be completing their adventure story by using what they learn at the beach and at the life boat station.

**Maths:** We will begin to look at fractions.

**Topic** time will be Geography linked by looking at the climates of Kenya in contrast with Nova Scotia as well as presenting the weather from a tropical rainforest at the equator.

## CLASS 3

**English:** Next week we are going to be focusing on poetry through short burst writing. We will be looking at images to inspire our ideas before creating vocabulary lists to help our WOW description in the poems. Children will be learning how to use similes, alliteration and onomatopoeia to bring their writing to life.

**Maths:** We are continuing with our focus on fractions next week. All children will be learning how to add and subtract fractions within a whole (Y3) and over a whole (Y4). Children will be applying this learning through missing number problems, word problems and investigations.

**Topic:** We shall be studying different artefacts to allow us to have a greater understanding about who the Anglo-Saxons were. Children will be taking on the roles of historians during the topic lessons.

**Science:** Next week we will be making musical instruments to show our understanding of sound. Children will be asked to make instruments that show a difference in pitch and volume.

## CLASS 4

**Class 4 Topic: Falmouth in the past.**

**English:** This week we will be writing a newspaper report on an aspect of our trip on Tuesday, and looking at incorporating quotes into our writing using the correct punctuation.

**Maths:** We will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. Rounding numbers including decimal numbers, recapping on working out missing number calculations and converting units of measure.

**Y5 target** - I can recall metric conversions.

**Y6 target** - I can convert between decimals, fractions and percentages.

**Topic** – On Tuesday we are visiting the Falmouth lifeboat station and Falmouth art gallery.

**RE:** Investigate and compare different aspects of Christianity e.g. Christians, Methodists, protestants.
