Over the next few weeks we will be learning about the *Great Fire of London*, London today, and then move closer to home to look at the differences between busy *City* life and our world in *Cornwall*. We will contrast the built up landscapes and associated wildlife to our coast and coastal habitats (including a visit to the maritime museum and beach).
