Attendance Reminder

Please remember to notify the school if your child is unable to attend, as all schools must record details of pupils' attendance and reasons for absence at school. A child can legally miss school when they are too ill to go to school or when the school has authorised the absence beforehand. It is therefore important that we know about planned absences in advance. If your child is missing school without reason, the local authority can use their legal powers to find out why. Please help us to comply with our legal obligation by notifying us of planned absences through completing absence request forms.

PTA Curriculum Books

We are very motivated about continuing to develop the curriculum and the learning opportunities that we offer the children at Mawnan School, and want to say a massive thank you to the PTA for funding the core texts that will support the delivery of the curriculum in the new academic year. Just a reminder that there is **NO** sailing on **Friday, 14th June 2019**, due to the Class 3 Camp.



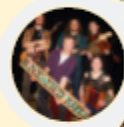
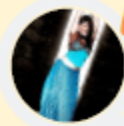
Head lice

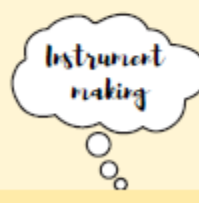
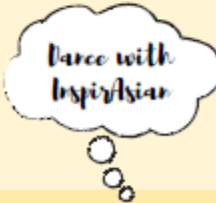
